

**MINUTES FOR MEETING OF DECEMBER 17, 2021**

A special meeting of the Pine Grove Township Supervisors was held on Friday, December 17, 2021 at 10:10 AM at the Town Hall. Supervisors present were Douglas Smith and Linda Farnsworth. Others present were Julie Parmenter.

Linda Farnsworth opened the special township meeting at 10:10 a.m.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

A motion was made to approve the minutes from the December 8 meeting by Linda Farnsworth. Douglas Smith seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

Next was a review of the insurance coverage quotes. Douglas Smith made a motion to accept the quote for liability insurance from Gray Insurance Agency. Linda Farnsworth seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

Douglas Smith advised that we have received the remainder of our salt from our previous contract.

Hultberg Road has been rolled again and it seems to be stabilizing. The Supervisor's will keep this road closed until further review.

The Big Four Road was reviewed and Douglas Smith would like to see a decision made on this in January. The Supervisor's advised the secretary to send out a letter to the property owners to advise them of the possible closure of this road.

Doug enlightened the others that he had sent an amendment to Steve Horsley on his article on roads.


The equipment is in good shape. The road crew have been doing maintenance on the equipment.

The Supervisors advised the secretary to send a letter to Mr. Bogniak to inquire on what his intentions are with his house on S. Main Street.

There was some talk on a possible location for the future construction of a new garage. Doug commented on Pleasant Township's garage and he would like to set up a time for the Supervisor's and Road Foreman to go view their garage. The secretary will contact Pleasant Township to set up a date and time.

Douglas Smith made a motion for adjournment at 10:55 AM. Linda Farnsworth seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.
