

MINUTES FOR MEETING OF MAY 23, 2025

The meeting of the Pine Grove Township Supervisors was held on Friday, May 23, 2025 at 8:30 AM at the Town Hall. Supervisors present were Douglas Smith, Robert Nelson and Linda Farnsworth. Others present were Julie Parmenter.

Doug Smith opened the meeting at 8:30 a.m.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Doug Smith read over the agenda and asked if there were any comments from visitors or residents.

No visitors were present.

A motion was made to approve the minutes from the May 14, 2025 meeting by Bob Nelson. Doug Smith seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

No representatives from the Fire Department were in attendance.

Bob informed the other Supervisor's that the road foreman found a used sander in very good condition that they could use for the new truck. After some discussion on the benefits of having another sander, it was decided to go ahead and tell the road foreman to purchase this. Bob Nelson made a motion to purchase the sander for the new truck. Doug Smith seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

There was an update on the Collin's case. The solicitor advised the secretary that since his attendance at a previous meeting, three more pleadings have been file by Mr. Collin's. Mr. Bevevino also advised that the current judge on this case is being replaced by a judge from another county.

Some conversation regarding available keys for the office was next. After a short discussion, it was determined that the only people that should have a key are the elected officials and employees.

Bob Nelson advised that there were some kids at Larimer Park with a golf cart a couple of weeks ago. He stated that after gravel was put down, they were doing donuts. Although it did not do any damage to the parking lot, there is concern about someone getting hurt. Bob put the word out that this incident was caught on camera at the park and there has not been any incidents since.

Doug Smith made a motion for adjournment at 8:51 am. Bob Nelson seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.
