

MINUTES FOR MEETING OF FEBRUARY 27, 2026

The meeting of the Pine Grove Township Supervisors was held on Friday, February 27, 2026 at 8:30 AM at the Town Hall. Supervisors present were Douglas Smith and Linda Farnsworth. Others present were Rich Barrett, Mike English and Julie Parmenter.

Doug Smith opened the meeting at 8:35 a.m.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Doug Smith read over the agenda and asked if there were any comments from visitors or residents.

Mike English attended the meeting to explain the current condition of the Fairbanks Road between Route 957 and the Eisenhower High School parking lot entrance. He advised that Farmington Township is planning on repairing that section of road with some stone and oil. Mike would like to request the use of the Pine Grove Township's roller for this section of road. Farmington Township would be willing to reciprocate in some way for the use of the equipment. The Supervisor's will inform the road foreman of this and they suggested that Farmington get in contact Dave to schedule a date that will work for everyone.

Rich Barrett attended the meeting to notify the Supervisor's that he will still serve as the Emergency Management Coordinator for the Township. The Supervisor's inquired about his abrupt resignation from the fire department. He advised that he received a disciplinary letter stating he was doing too much and then made the decision to remove himself from the department.

A motion was made to approve the minutes from the February 11, 2026 meeting by Linda Farnsworth. Doug Smith seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

No representatives from the fire department were present.

A motion to adopt **Resolution #2-27-26** to allocate the 2026 County Aid funds in the amount of \$7,520 for road maintenance was made by Linda Farnsworth. Doug Smith seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

Doug Smith made a motion for adjournment at 9:12 am. Linda Farnsworth seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.
