

MINUTES FOR MEETING OF JUNE 26, 2026

The meeting of the Pine Grove Township Supervisors was held on Friday, June 26, 2026 at 8:30 AM at the Town Hall. Supervisors present were Doug Smith, Robert Nelson and Linda Farnsworth. Others present were Dale Trubic and Julie Parmenter.

Doug Smith opened the meeting at 8:30 a.m.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Doug Smith read over the agenda and asked if there were any comments from visitors or residents.

No visitors were present.

A motion was made to approve the minutes from the June 10, 2026 meeting by Bob Nelson. Linda Farnsworth seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

Next was Dale Trubic to give an update from the Russell VFD. He advised they have been doing well with the ambulance responses. He noted that there have been some trees down in the area and the road crew and the Fire Department have work together to get them cleaned up and he thanked the Township for their help. He reported on the new EMT's and they are doing good. He also advised that the merger is not looking like that is something that the Fire Department will be entering into.

Dale noted that they need to get applications more readily available. Linda suggested that they bring some applications to the office and they could also be available there and also put it on the Township's website.

The upcoming replacement of the Water Authority Operator was discussed. They talked about who is responsible for the hiring and who they can get for the operator's replacement. They noted that Nate and Dave from North Warren Municipal Authority are their first points of contact. It was decided to contact them and talk about if they have any interest in taking over our system.

CDBG Funding was the next item discussed. It was noted that this funding is based on low- and moderate-income areas and must be utilized to prevent or eliminate blight and must meet an emergency need. They Supervisor's discussed what this funding encompasses and if road maintenance would qualify for funding. They stated that they need some clarification on what kind of projects would qualify. It was stated they the Supervisor's need to decide on a project and then contact the grant administrator to see if it is a qualifying project.

Doug Smith made a motion for adjournment at 9:38 am. Linda Farnsworth seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.
